

## Travelling

Visitors arriving in Cyprus by air, may enter the Republic of Cyprus only through the International Airports of Larnaka and Pafos.

Entry via any other airport is illegal. The so-called "Ergan" airport is illegal and not recognized by ICAO.

The main one is Larnaka International Airport which is 70 km from Limassol, whereas Pafos Airport is 63 km from Limassol.


